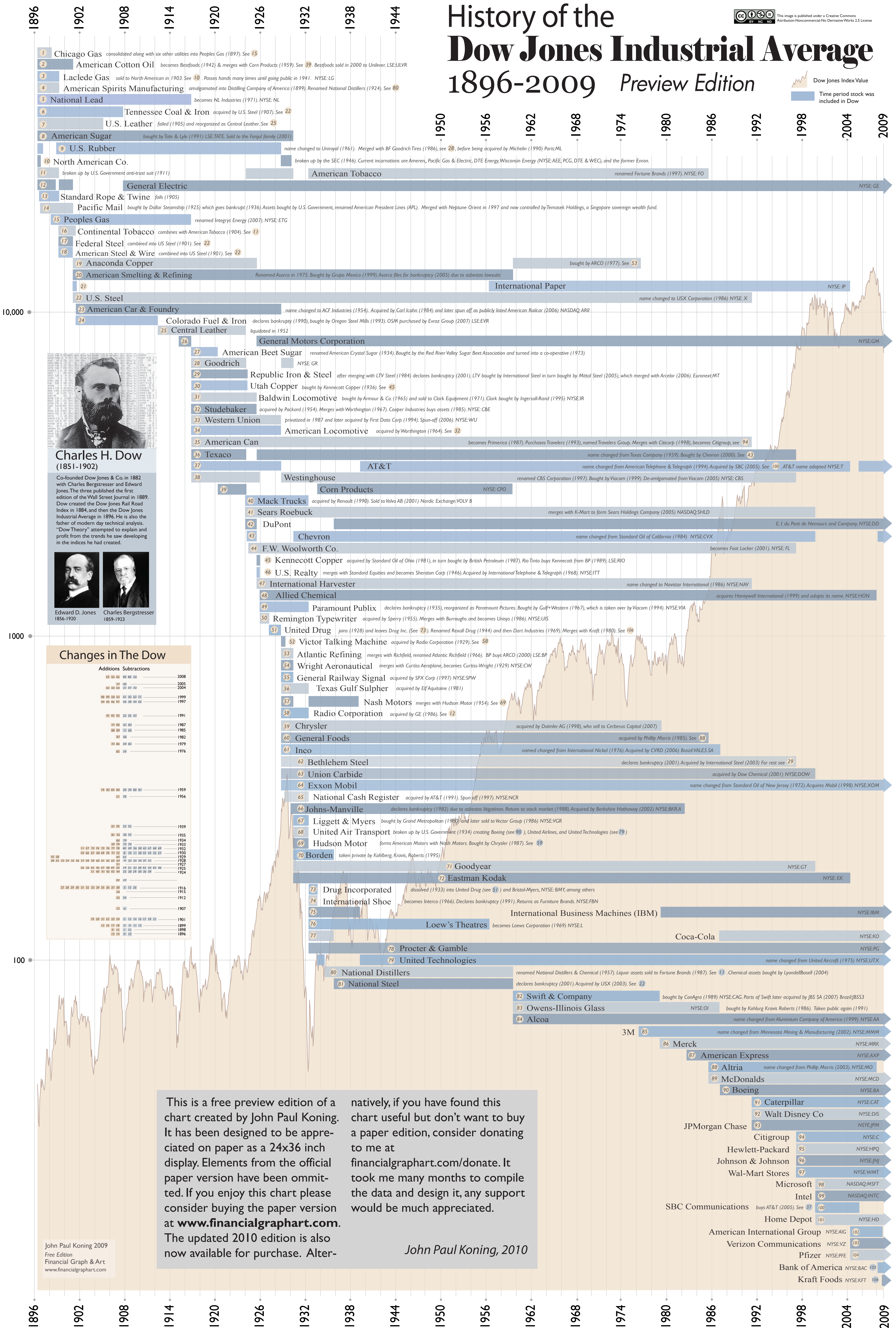


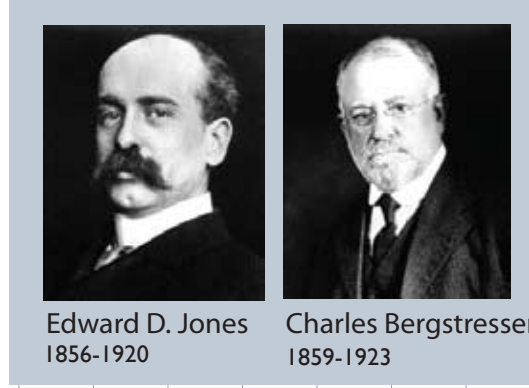
History of the Dow Jones Industrial Average 1896-2009 Preview Edition

Charles H. Dow
(1851-1902)

Co-founded Dow Jones & Co. in 1882 with Charles Bergstresser and Edward Jones. The three published the first edition of the Wall Street Journal in 1889. Dow created the Dow Jones Rail Road Index in 1884, and then the Dow Jones Industrial Average in 1896. He is also the father of modern day technical analysis. "Dow Theory" attempted to explain and profit from the trends he saw developing in the indices he had created.
